Areas with Art Exhibits

- Areas with art exhibits, and their surroundings, are residential zones. Please do not shout or yell, or cause any other trouble to local residents.
- Some areas have heavy vehicle traffic. Please be cautious of vehicles, follow traffic rules, and do not obstruct the flow of traffic.
- Temporary parking spots are provided in both Shido and Tsuda. Please leave your car parked, and travel to the artworks in each area on foot, not by car.

Heatstroke Prevention Measures

- Make sure to check for available rest areas in advance, take frequent breaks, use sun protection such as sun umbrellas or hats, and drink water regularly to prevent heatstroke.
- Sun umbrellas are available to borrow at information centers and other locations, so please feel free to use them.

An area steeped in history and culture with Buddhist pilgrimage sites and a famous pine grove.



Sanuki City, which encompasses what were formerly the towns of Shido and Tsuda, is located in eastern Kagawa and has a population of about 47,000.

Shido is home to Shido Temple, the 86th temple on Shikoku's 88 Temple Pilgrimage route. The town developed as a commercial and distribution center for farm products during the Edo period (1603-1868).

Tsuda is known for its scenic white beach bordered by a large pine grove that extends about one kilometer. The area retains traces of its heyday as a fishermen's town, and shirasu (whitebait), a special product of the area, can still be seen lain out to dry in the sun every July.

Tsuda no Matsubara

A kilometer-long sandy beach facing onto the Seto Inland Sea, edged by a grove of more than 3,000 mature pine trees with exposed roots. One of the most famous beauty spots in Kagawa Prefecture.



Uratsuda

This seaside area features a cluster of renovated "kominka" houses, such as cafes, workshops, and shops selling various goods. With new initiatives coexisting alongside historical charm, Uratsuda is scattered with a diverse range of establishments. A recommended destination for a stroll around town, where you can enjoy new shops as well as nostalgic scenery.



Negaibashi Kanaebashi Bridge

The outbound path of the bridge is named "Negaibashi" (Wishing Bridge), while the return path is "Kanaebashi" (Wish-granted Bridge). One bridge with two names.



Tsuda Iwashimizu Shrine

A shrine located within Tsuda no Matsubara. This is the only shrine in Kagawa Prefecture with "komainu" (shrine guardian dog statues) that are Japanese wolves.



Tsuda no Matsubara Shoten

Located just 30 seconds' walk from the artworks and the beach. At Senshintei, a former traditional restaurant, a local produce sales corner operated by the Sanuki City Tsuda District Community Planning Association will be open for a limited period! In addition to a wide range of specialty products from the Tosan (eastern Sanuki) area including Sanuki City, Higashikagawa City, and Miki Town, there is also a sightseeing guide to the region. During the open period, three types of cameras are available to rent!

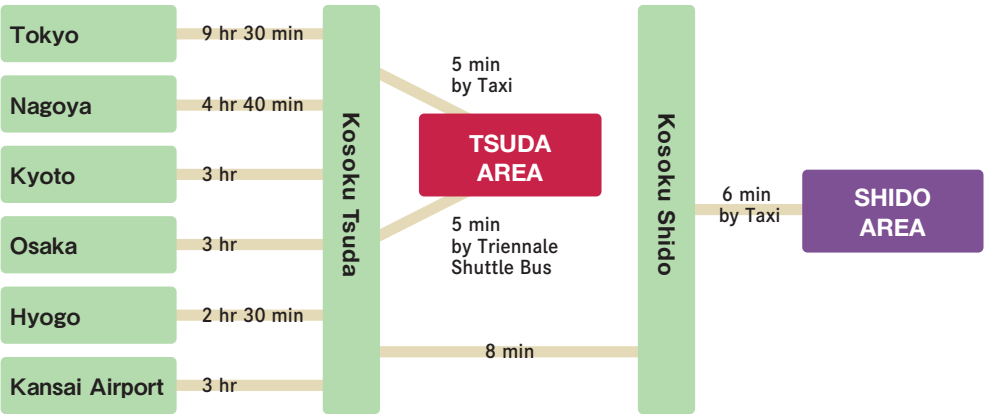
